Following is an outline of the trash and recycling services for Beaver Borough Residents:

Trash service pick-up is once a week. A standard trash can or bag is 32 gallons. Anything larger will not be taken.

Extras

You can get rid of your extra trash several ways.

- Borough Bags – purchase bags from the Borough Building. The bags are \$2.00 each and include the cost of disposal. When you fill up a Borough Bag, just put it out on your normal trash day. You will not pay any extra fees except for the purchase of the bag.
- Call In – you can call in to our office to arrange for pick-up of your extra trash. The charge for the extra trash is determined by the driver at the time of the pick-up and will appear on your quarterly invoice.
- Clean-up Day – once a year, usually in the spring, the Borough has a clean-up day when you can put out your extra and bulky trash.

Recycling

- **Tin Cans / Metal Cans / Bi-Metal Cans / Aluminum Cans / Aluminum Foil** – empty of contents. No chemical or paint cans.
- **Glass** – rinsed out and empty of contents. Lids must be removed. Do not break. Food or beverage containers only. No light bulbs, windows, glasses, plates, etc.
- **Plastic - #1 and #2 (PET & HDPE)** – empty of contents. Lids must be removed.

Recycle bins should be placed on the curb and the material can be placed in a recycle bin, garbage can, or other rigid container.

Billing / Payment

Invoice on a quarterly basis and in the middle of the quarter. You can mail in your payment or drop it off at the box located on the first floor of the Borough Building. We accept credit cards over the telephone and we can also automatically debit your bank account or credit card. Please call us at 724-775-6665 about this option.

Pick up dates

1st Monday of the month – River Road to south of Third Street

2nd Monday of the month – North of Third Street up to 7th Street
