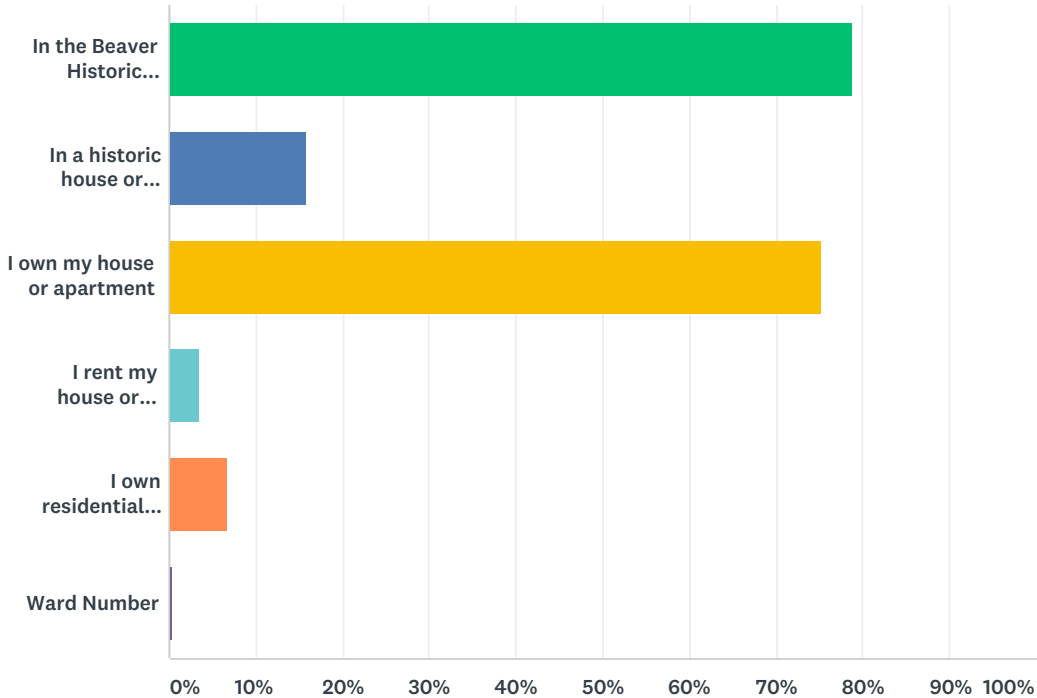


Q1 Where do you live? (check all that apply). A map showing the boundaries of the Beaver Historic District is above.

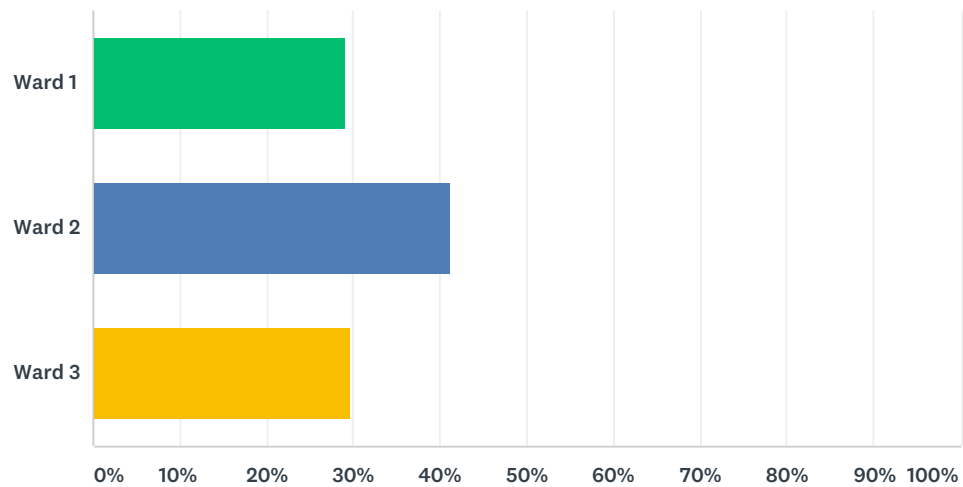

Q2 What is your Ward number? (see map from Question 1)

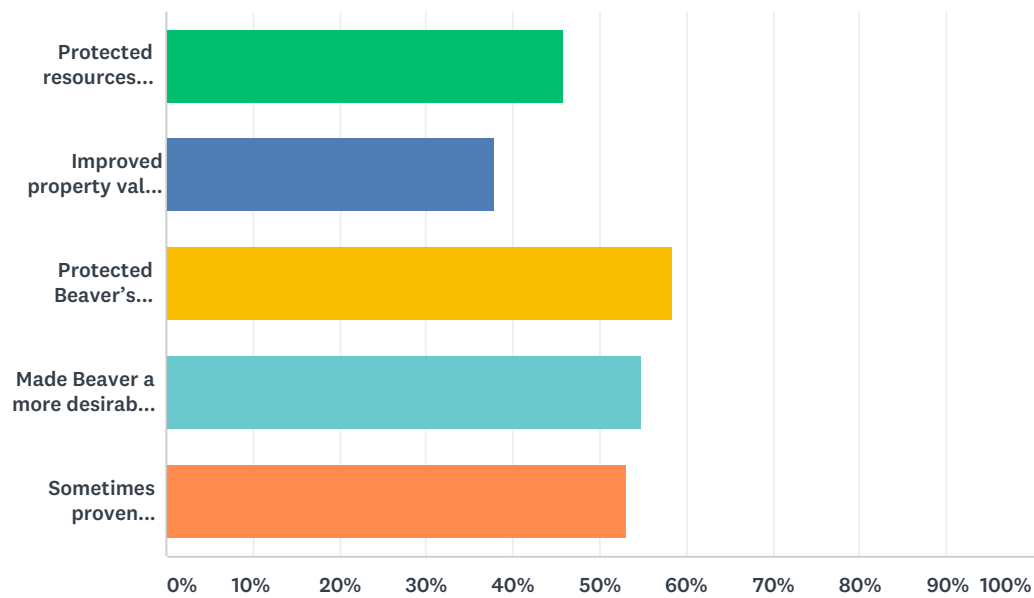

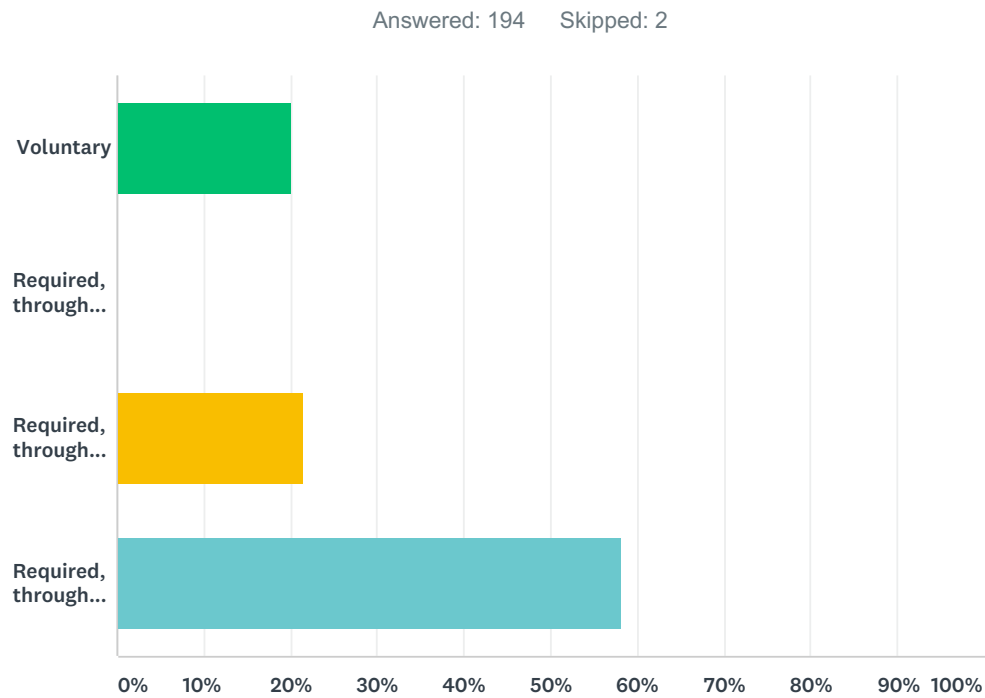

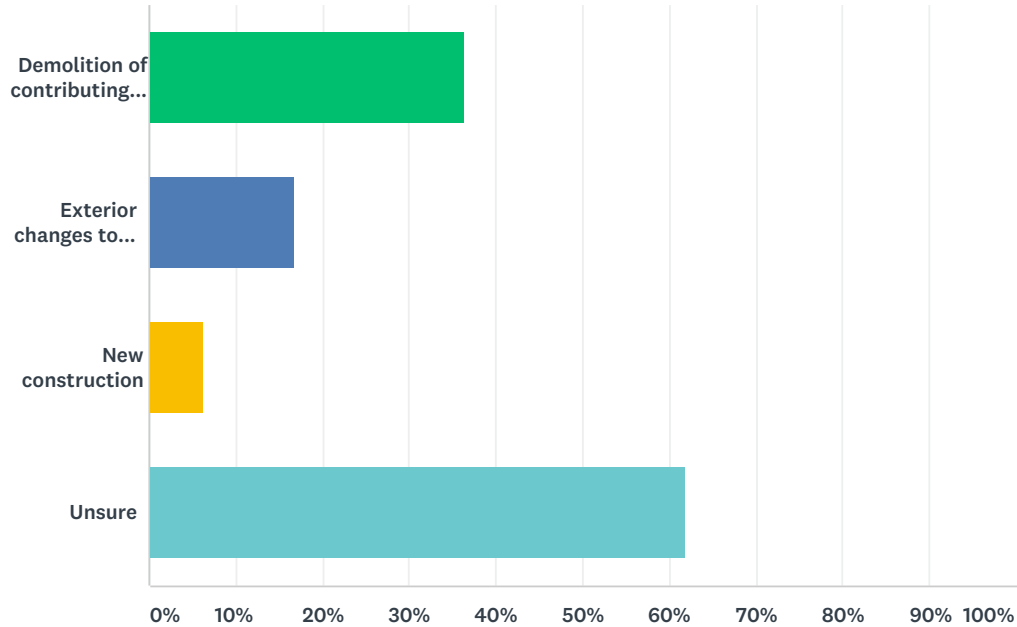

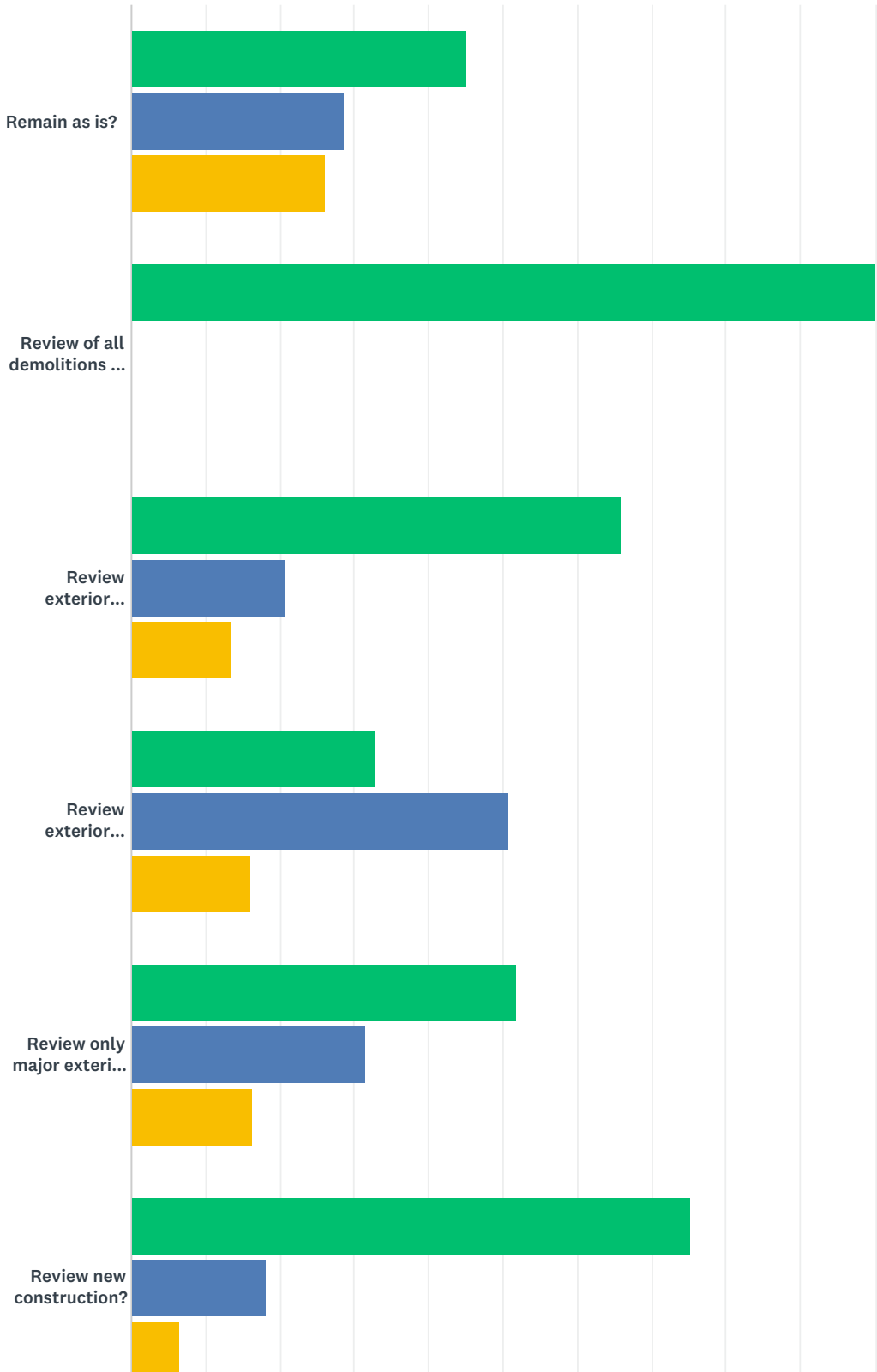

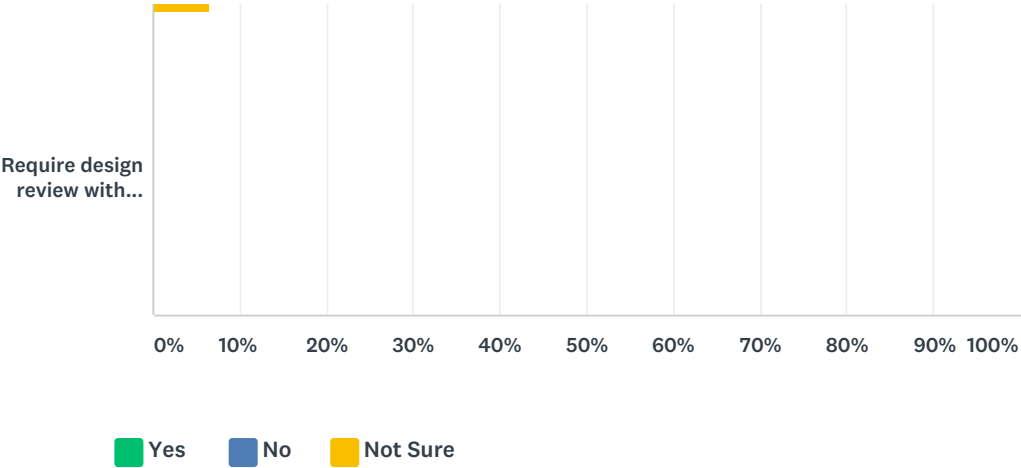

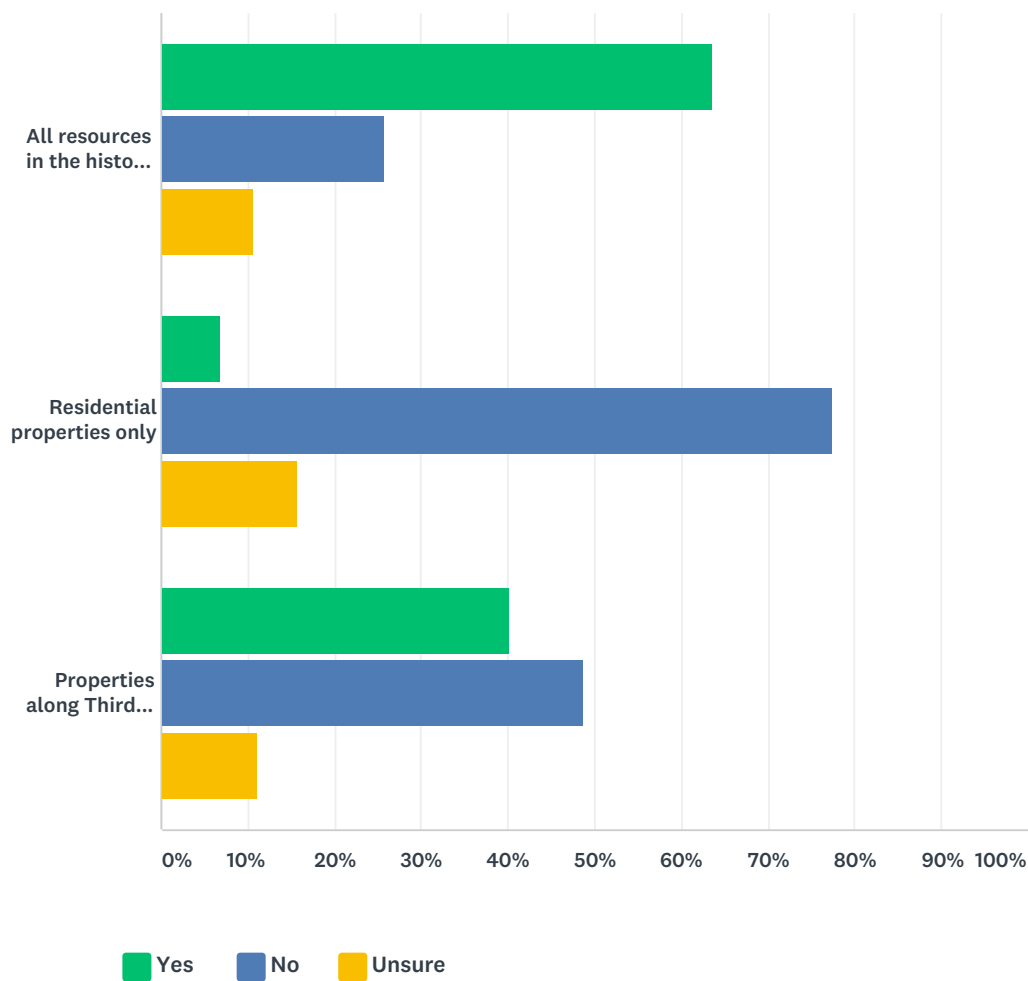

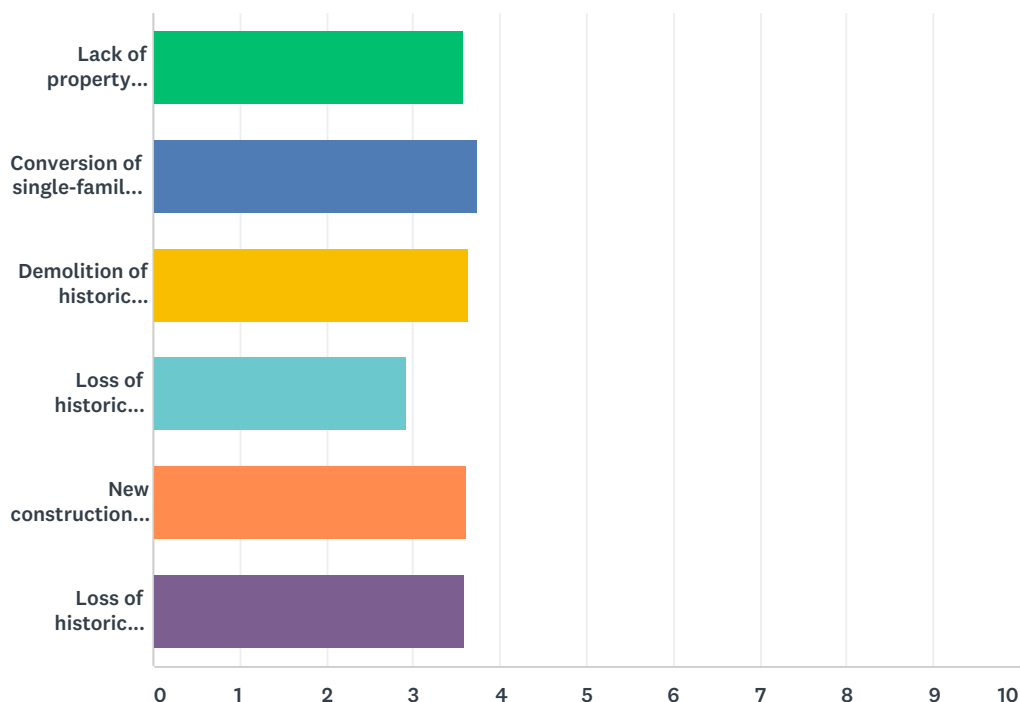

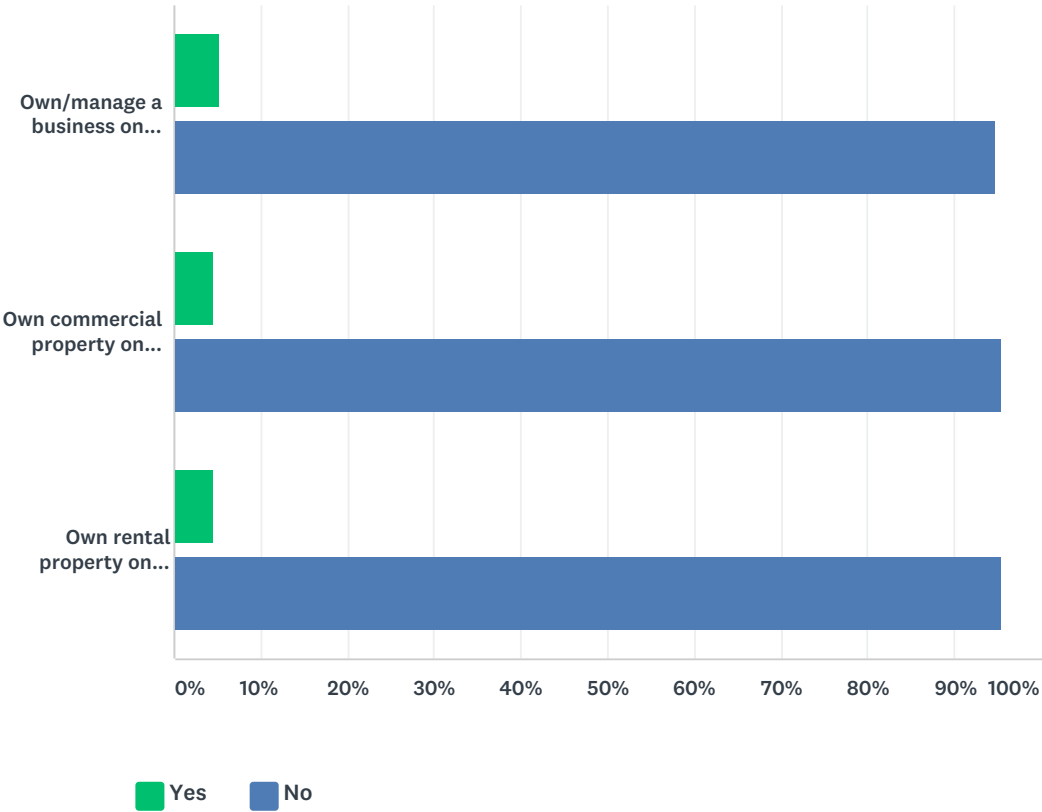
## Q8 On a scale from 'No Threat' to 'Major Threat', how would you rank the following threats to the quality of residential neighborhoods?

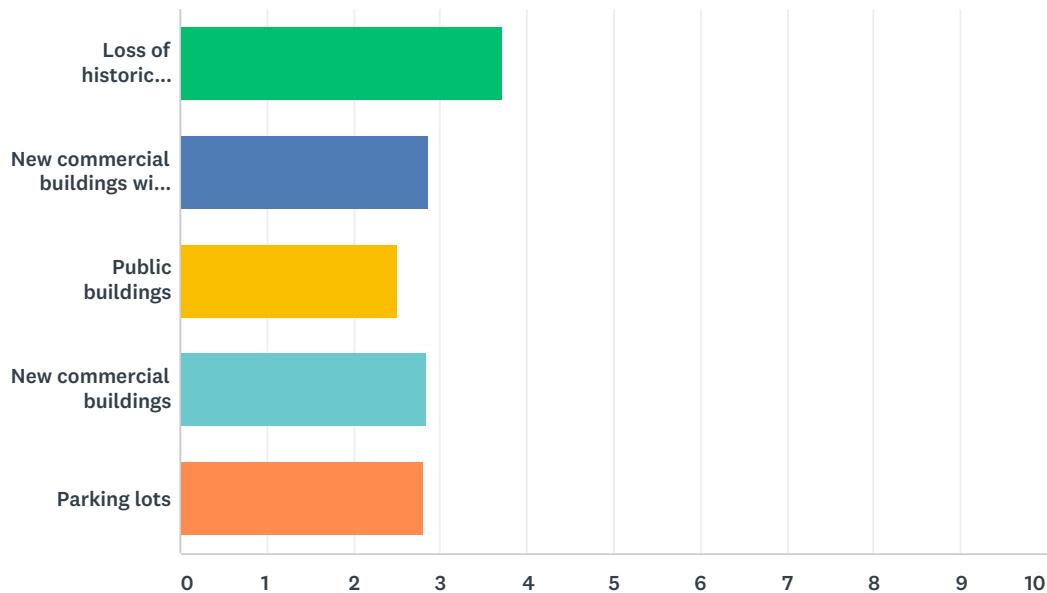

## Q10 On a scale from 'No Threat' to 'Major Threat', how would you rank the following threats to the historic shopping environment of Third Street:

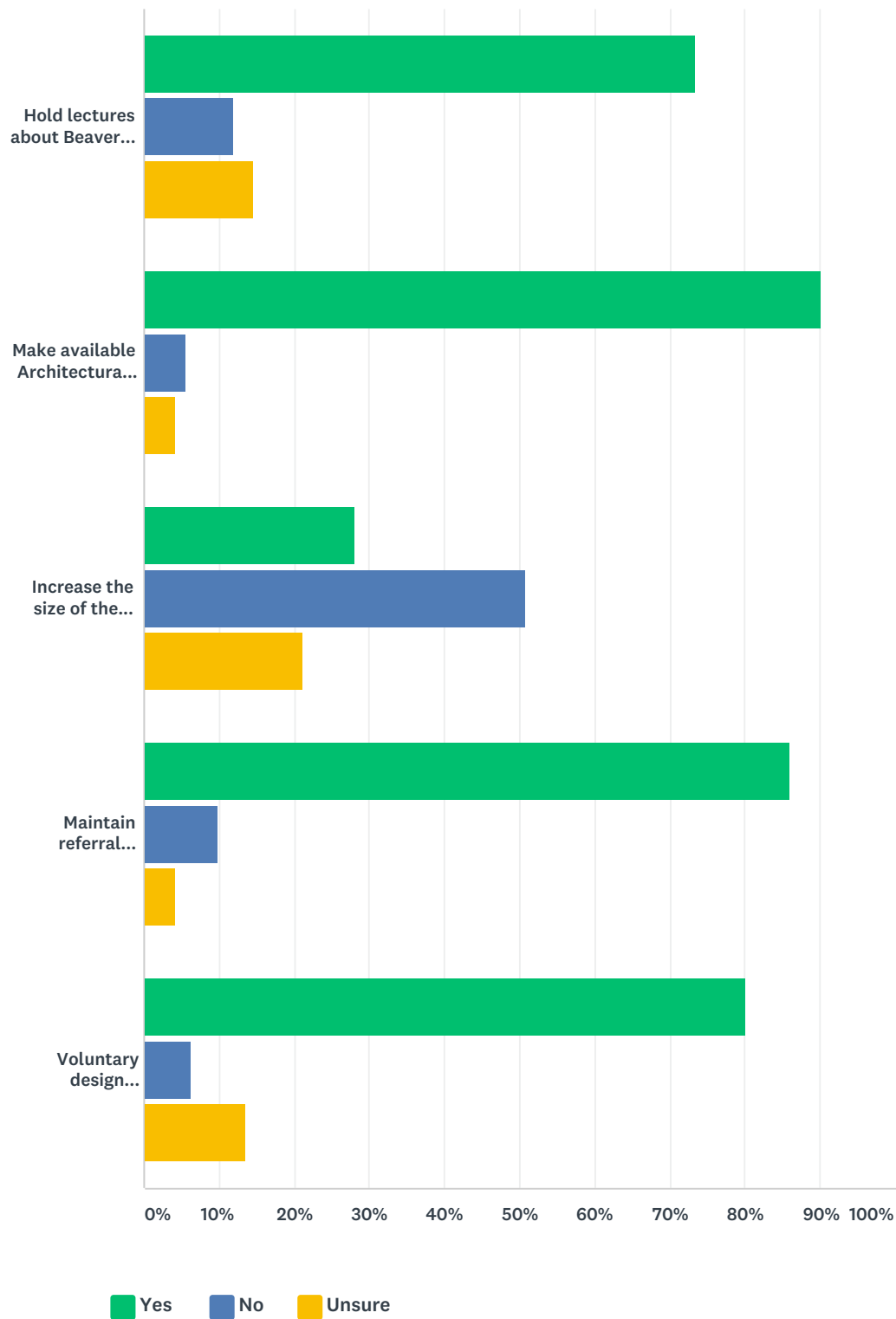
