Beaver Borough Community Recreation Survey Take-aways

Overview:

- 812 people took the Community Recreation Survey over a 21-day period. 60% of the respondents are from the Borough (489); 34% are from the School District (277); and 6% are from outside the School District (46).
- There are 2,002 households in the Borough; we assume that each respondent spoke for a household, that equals to approximately 24% of the Borough's households participated. A general planning standard goal is a 10% return.

Demographic:

- The majority (more than 70%) of those surveyed visited the Park and maintained an annual membership at the pool over the past 3 years.
- The largest cohorts of Park and Pool visitors concentrate in the 5-12 year age group and the 36-49 year age group. This is an indication of families.

Park:

- In ranking the most appealing park amenities, the top 6 (in order of priority) are: Borough Pool, lawn area, large trees, pavilion, picnic/BBQ grill area, and tennis courts. The Borough Pool was noted as the most important feature by nearly twice as many votes as the second ranked lawn area.
- In ranking the ideal improvement, the top 6 (in order of priority) are: improved playground, outdoor fireplace, casual seating, rentable event space, gathering area, outdoor fireplace.
- The most valued feature in Shaw Park is tree cover.

Borough Pool:

- 87% think the existing admission fee to the Borough Pool is reasonable.
- In choosing the most desirable new features in the pool, the top 6 (in order of priority) are: shaded area, wading pool, spray pad, beach/zero entry, lawn area, and a larger water slide.
- 64% are interested in attending aquatic fitness programs in the Pool, while 56% do not require an age-specific swim time.
- 69% are interested in rental space in the pool for events and 57% are interested in providing age-specific swim areas.

Bath House:

• Renovation of the existing Bath House was chosen by 81% surveyed. Restrooms, changing rooms, showers and concession areas are the top 4 ranked amenities/functions to have within a renovated bath house.



Q1 Where do you live?






Q3 Have you or any members of your household made use of the Borough Pool in the past 3 years (2018, 2019 or 2020)?






Q5 Which of the following entrance fee options have you or your family used in the past year to access the Borough Pool?



Q6 What existing Park amenity or feature is most appealing to you and your household members? Please select up to four choices.












Q10 Do you feel the current Borough Pool serves all ages in the community?





Q11 Do you feel the cost of admission to the Borough Pool is reasonable?









Q14 Would you or anyone in your household be interested in attending aquatic fitness programs, if offered?





Q15 Would you like to see designated, age-specific swim areas within a New Borough Pool, if approved?





Q16 Would you like to see designated, age-specific swim times?






