

## Waste Disposal & Recycling Service

The following is an outline of the trash and recycling services for Beaver Borough Residents:

### **Billing / Payment**

Residents are invoiced on a quarterly basis and in the middle of the quarter. Payment can be mailed in or dropped off at the box located on the first floor of the Borough Building. Brunner's accepts credit cards over the phone and can automatically debit a bank account or credit card. Please call Brunner's directly at (724) 775-6665 to set this up.

### **Garbage Service**

- Garbage pick-up service is once per week. A can is considered a 30-40 gallon sized can and should weigh no more than 40lbs. We will invoice larger sized cans as 2 or 3 cans depending on the size.
- Items not accepted included yard waste, grass clippings, tree branches, electronic devices, car parts, batteries, hazardous waste, chemicals, thermostats and nothing containing mercury.
- Bulky, odd or extra items are not included in the weekly trash pick-up. Please call us at (724) 775-6665 to make arrangements to have them picked up.

#### *Extra Garbage:*

- **Borough bags** – residents can purchase trash bags for extra trash or in lieu of subscription service at the Borough Office during regular office hours. Put this bag out on your normal trash day and you will not pay any extra fees except for the purchase of the bag.
- **Call in** – you can call in to Brunner's office to arrange for pick-up of your extra trash. The charge for the extra trash is determined by the driver at the time of pick-up and will appear on your quarterly invoice.
- **Clean up day** – once a year, typically in the Spring, Beaver Borough has a clean-up day when you can put out your extra and bulky trash for pick-up.

## Recycling Service

- Recycling service pick-up is every other Monday. Please place on the curb or accessible area for pickup.
- Call the Beaver Borough Office for recycling bin availability at (724) 773-6700
- Your recycling container is to be used for recycling only. Please recover your recycling container promptly after collection. The container remains the property of the Beaver Borough and must remain at the residence if you move.
- Place all of your recyclable materials in the bin. No need to separate it. Leave it loose or in a brown paper bag. Do not place any of it in a plastic bag.

### *Recycling Guidelines:*

- **Tin Cans / Metal Cans / Bi-Metal Cans / Aluminum Cans / Aluminum Foil** – rinsed and empty of contents. No chemical or paint cans.
- **Plastic** - #1 and #2 (PET & HDPE) – such as pop bottles, milk jugs and laundry detergent containers. Empty of contents, and please remove lids.
- **Paper** from news, magazines, junk mail, construction paper, catalogs, and paper bags.
- **Boxboard or paperboard** like cereal and cracker boxes, shoe boxes, soda pop and beer cartons. Clean and empty of contents. No liners.
- **Cardboard boxes** – broken down so it is flat.
- **Glass** – Please call Waste Management located at Brady's Run Park – (724) 770-2064 or visit their website for hours of operation.

*Please no garbage, food waste, glass, diapers, wax or plastic wrap or bags, plastic deli bags or take out packaging, Styrofoam or Styrofoam packing peanuts, window glass, ceramics or dishware, mirror or light bulbs / florescent light bulbs, dog waste or kitty litter, Tupperware or Rubbermaid plastic containers. These items go in the trash can.*
